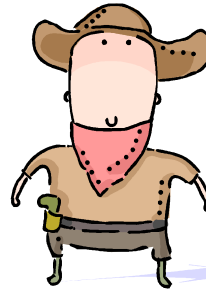

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ★ All participating in parade and to be eligible for prizes must be registered by 12 noon the day of the event. **ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRIES ARRIVING AFTER 12 NOON WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES – NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ★ No registrations will be accepted after 12 noon.
- ★ Formation of Parade:
 - ◆ All divisions will form at fairgrounds gate and proceed down main walk to stage.
 - ◆ All awards will be presented on stage.



RULES

1. In all divisions, the decoration subject, theme, and costumes worn only by child or children taking part will be considered by the judges. No adults in costume.
2. Any child up to and including first grade may compete, but the chairman of the parade reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. The judges' decisions will be final, based on **workmanship** and **originality**.
4. Entries will be accepted at registration table from 11 a.m. to 12 noon the day of the event. **No entries will be accepted after 12 noon!**
5. The distribution or throwing of any articles such as candy, etc. and the use of large or small animals for riding by entrants is forbidden.
6. No motorized vehicles are permitted to pull floats or any other entry. **Manpower** only. All entries must be pulled across stage.
7. Participants may enter in ONE DIVISION and ONE CLASS ONLY.
8. Division and class entries with more than one child in the group will receive only one trophy the day of the event—any additional trophy(ies) will be ordered as necessary after the event.
