- 4. Foot power only (exceptions may be arranged for special needs).
- 5. Wagons and strollers are allowed at one per parade entry because of space.
- 6. Pet owners must pick up their pet's "refuse" before, during, and after the parade. Bring necessary disposable bags.
- 7. Pets must have current rabies vaccinations. Written proof must be provided during the check-in process.
- 8. Unruly animal behavior will result in request to leave fairgrounds.
- 9. Bring animal at your own risk. The Atlantic County 4-H Fair Association, volunteers, employees, licensees, or guests will not be held liable for any injury, damage, or any cause whatsoever.
