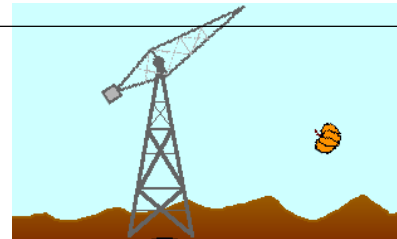
This 2-day camp is an exciting, engaging experience for your young engineer. Fun, imaginative sessions include:

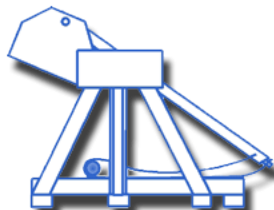
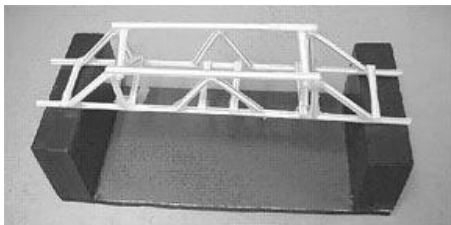
